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This matter having come before the Court on the parties' Stipulation Regarding Interim
Agreement and Joint Motion Amending Case Schedule, docket no. 99, and having been fully
heard and duly considered it is hereby

ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Parties' Interim Agreement, Exhibit 1 to their Stipulation, docket no. 99, is APPROVED, and the Parties' Joint Motion Amending Case Schedule, docket no. 99, is GRANTED.
- 2. The Court is persuaded that the Interim Agreement does not impede the rights of individual class members, who remain free to adjudicate their claims during the course of the Interim Agreement, and that notice to class members pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e) is not required.
- 3. The trial date of March 11, 2013, and all related deadlines are STRICKEN.
- 4. As set forth in the Parties' Stipulation, this case will remain on the Court's active docket, and the Court shall have jurisdiction to enforce the terms of the Parties' Stipulation, including the requirements and admissions of the Interim Agreement incorporated therein, which the Parties have stipulated are binding upon them in this action. All discovery and further litigation activity, other than that described in the Interim Agreement, is STAYED pending further order of the Court.
- 5. The Parties are DIRECTED to file, not later than June 15, 2013, a Joint Status Report regarding the status of the implementation of the Interim Agreement, the status of continuing mediation efforts, and the resolution of the case.

6. The Clerk is DIRECTED to UNSEAL the Parties' Stipulation and Motion, docket no. 99. The Clerk is further DIRECTED to send a copy of this Order to all counsel of record. IT IS SO ORDERED. DATED this 7th day of March, 2012. United States District Judge

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
